SECOND CIRCULAR

The EGAN 2012 Workshop of the European Gamma and Ancillary detectors Network will take place in Orsay, France, on the 25-27 of June 2012. The Workshop will be followed by meetings of the EGAN networking groups on Thursday 28th of June and a meeting to discuss the new Letters of Intent for the AGATA campaign at GSI on Thursday the 28th of June and Friday the 29th of June.

The aim of the EGAN 2012 Workshop is to present the status of gamma-spectroscopy research in Europe and to discuss its perspectives, with special emphasis on the use and development of ancillary detectors.

Review talks are planned with ample time scheduled for discussion. These reviews will be followed by shorter contributions selected from the submitted abstracts. **The deadline for abstract submission has been extended to the 13th of April 2012.** Information regarding the abstract selection will be notified to the

contributors by the 4th of May 2012.

The morning of the 28th of June will be devoted to the meetings of the EGAN Scientific Committee and Working groups coordinating the ancillary instrumentation development. These will take place in meeting rooms at CSNSM and IPNO.

Meeting to discuss new proposals for the AGATA/PreSpec campaign at GSI

The AGATA/PreSPEC campaign is aimed at in-flight spectroscopy of exotic nuclei at the GSI Fragment Recoil Separator. The afternoon of Thursday the 28th of June and all day Friday the 29th of June will be dedicated to a meeting to present and discuss proposals for this campaign to be submitted to the GSI PAC at the end of this year.
