

A Paris Touristic Walk




Take the RER-B to Saint Michel Notre Dame

You'll walk in front of the Fontaine Saint Michel. Then continue along the Seine till the Musee d'Orsay. You will meet the Pont des Arts. Walk along the long the Quai Voltaire (where Voltaire died and where the "peau de chagrin" of Balzac was supposed to take place) You'll meet the "Bouquinistes" up to the famous Musee d'Orsay installed in the old train station. You'll also see the Passerelle Leopold Sedar Senghor



You'll can continue along the Seine, meet the Assemblee Nationale and arrive in front of the Invalides' garden: you can go closer to the impressive Invalides' Hotel and close to the Dome where Napoleon 1rst is buried.



Cross the Seine using the Pont Alexandre III up to the Grand Palais, situated in the bottom of the Champs Elysees, have a look at its glass roof. Then cross the Place de la Concorde till the Jardin des tuileries. If you do not feel tired yet you can push a little further north to meet the Place Vendome. Then back to the Jardin des Tuileries to the Louvres. And then back to Saint Michel crossing the Seine through the Ile De la Cite, passing close to the Conciergerie.
