After getting off the train, walk north along the platform (the same direction as the train). Exit D is at the end of the platform.




Option 2: Shuttle Bus



Weather

Currency Exchange

The local currency is the Hong Kong dollar (HKD). It is pegged to the US dollar at a rate of approximately US\$1 to HK\$7.8. Holders of PLUS / Cirrus / Discover / Diners Club debit cards may withdraw HKD at most ATMs in Hong Kong. Avoid using Travelex at the Airport as the exchange rate is unfavourable.

Payment Methods

Major credit cards are accepted in most mid to top-range hotels and department stores. Taxis in Hong Kong accept cash only. Fares of MTR trains and buses can be paid by Octopus Card or in cash.

Octopus Card is the most convenient payment method. Not only for public transport, you may also use it for dining, entertainment, shopping and more. You may purchase a Sold Tourist Octopus at any 7-ELEVEN or get an On-Loan Octopus at any MTR station customer service centre. More Info

Local Transportation

MTR is convenient and efficient transport to get around Hong Kong. It connects to various famous landmarks and tourist attractions (e.g. Mong Kok and Tsim Sha Tsui). MTR trains run from around 6:00 AM till around midnight.
