THE CALANQUES AND THE ISLANDS offer some of the best views of the city of Marseille (including the Chateau of If and the Fort Saint-Jean). The sport-lovers may like to explore the famous corniche that sets out from the Plage des Catalans with views over Prado Bay, cheer on the Olympique de Marseille football team in the emblematic Vélodrome stadium or discover the rich marine life that is highly prized by divers.

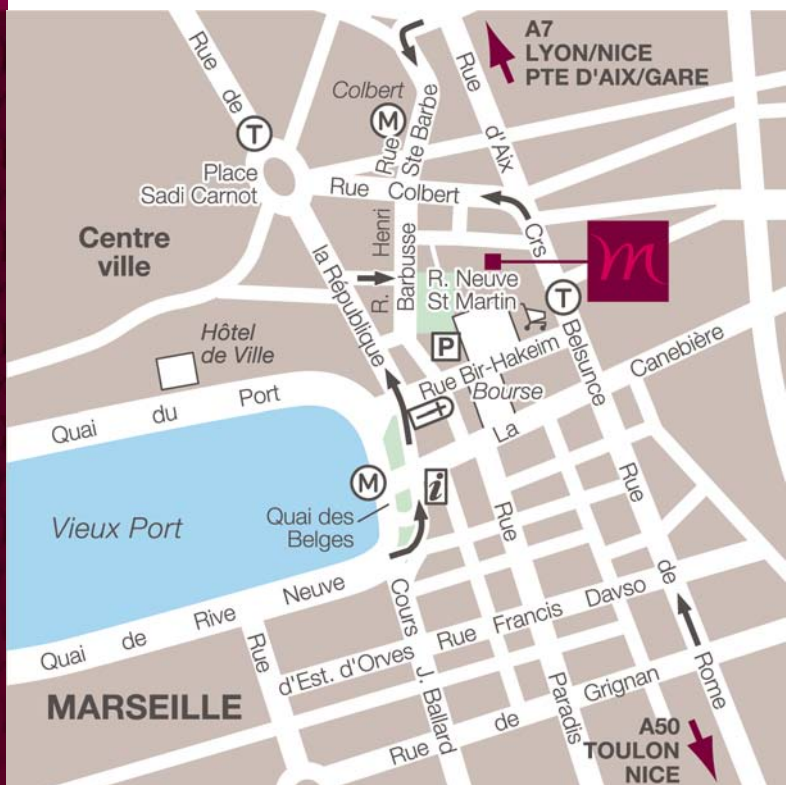
