

Results of the poll on future intensity wishes

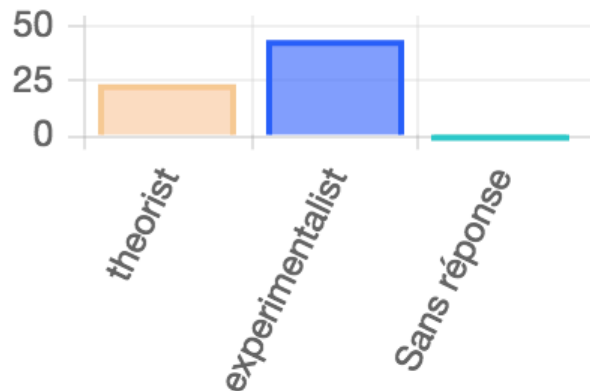

- 2) Method: ask straightforward questions, hoping for some significance on simple outcomes.

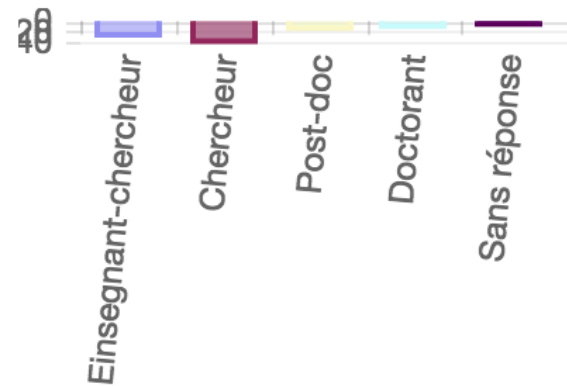
Results

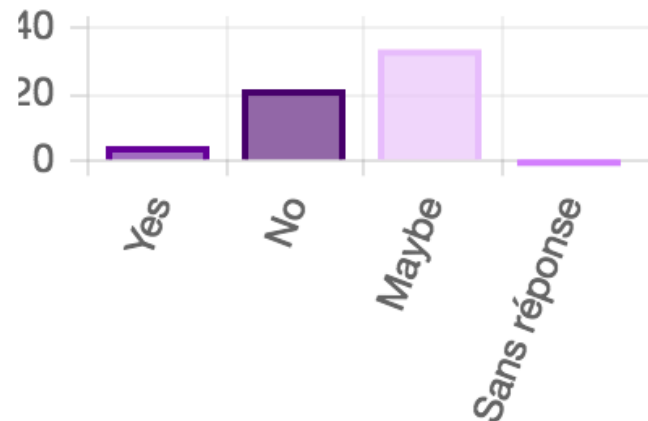


What is your current situation?



1) Beam dump experiments (complete answers)

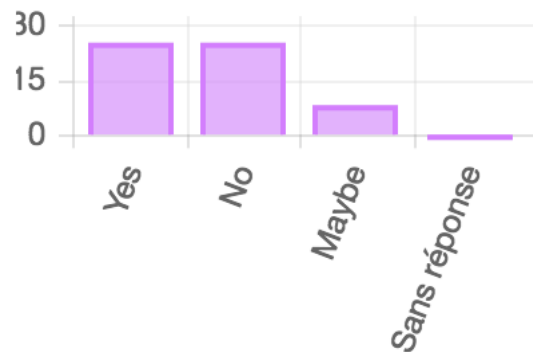
Should one (or several) beam dump experiment(s) be approved, would you consider to join this program ?

2) LHCb Phase II (complete answers)

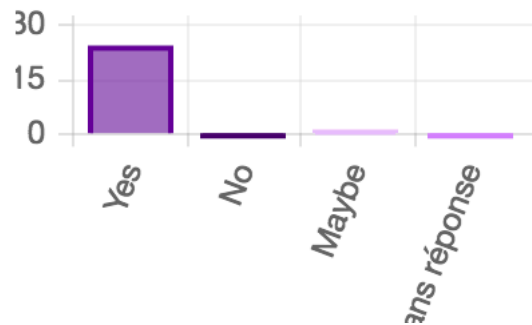
Are you considering to work on the developments of the LHCb upgrade II (HL-Phase)?

2) LHCb Phase II (complete answers)

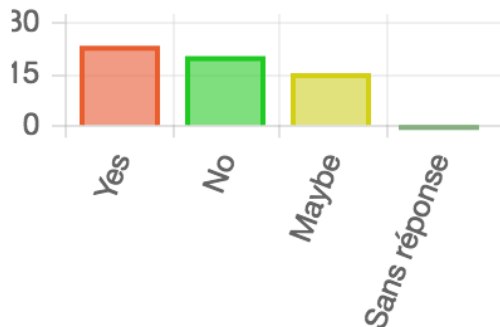
If Yes, would you be in favor of a joint effort (at least in detector developments) of the French community ?



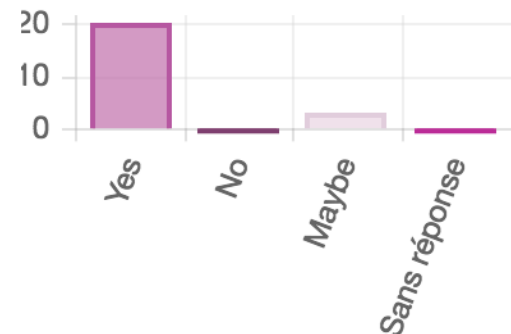
Super polarised. Great. We all want to work together. The Marseille's meeting showed as well there are a lot of projects.

Should the ESPP encourage the emergence of an e⁺e⁻ collider at Cern (with a Z pole program), would you consider to join the effort?



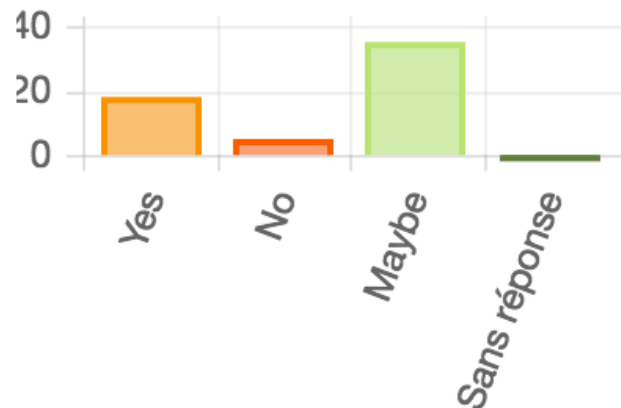
If yes, would you be in favor of a joint effort (at least in detector developments) of the French community ?
