
## ESCAPE Task 3.5

  - Make sure the minimal information is given
    - Service description and purpose
    - Prerequisites
    - Installation procedure
    - Test files or code
    - Examples and/or tutorials
    - Authors
    - License
    - Releases, versionning...
    - Acknowledgements

    - Features (see <a href="https://about.gitlab.com/">https://about.gitlab.com/</a>):
      - Code versioning
      - Management: Audit, A&A, Project boards

      - Monitoring: metrics, logging...




