The “Field and Particles” & “Nuclear” divisions of the French Physics Society (SFP) jointly organize the Journées de Rencontres Jeunes Chercheurs (JRJC) 2019 conference, to be held at the nautic center of **Moulin-Mer, in Finistère region – France, from November 24<sup>th</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

The 2019 edition is supported by the CEA, the CNRS-IN2P3, the FRIF (Fédération de Recherche Interactions Fondamentales), the Subatech and the LAL (Laboratoire de l'accélérateur linéaire) research institutes.

This conference aims at gathering young researchers who are in their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of PhD, although 1<sup>st</sup> year PhD students as well as young post-doc researchers are also welcome to participate. The JRJC are a very good opportunity for the participants to share their research work and get an overview of the latest research developments achieved in his/her field, within a nice and laid-back environment. A 4-pages proceeding summarizing the work presented will be produced in the following of this conference week.

Research topics covered by the JRJC 2019 conference are the following: astroparticle physics, nuclear astrophysics, beyond standard model, cosmology, theoretical physics, nuclear energy, instrumentation, medical physics, electroweak standard model, neutrinos, hadronic physics, flavor physics, nuclear structure. JRJCs are open to all young researchers, both experimenters and theoreticians.

Presentations can be given either in english or french. The social program includes an afternoon excursion on Wednesday, November 27<sup>th</sup>, consisting of a boat trip, a visit to an ancient abbey and a local brewery on the Crozon Peninsula, followed by a gala evening. A general public lecture will also be given on the afternoon of Thursday, 28 November, on the theme of assessing the effects of plastic debris on marine ecosystems.

In case you are a PhD student and you wish your participation to the JRJC to be formally recognized as a part of your training modules, do not hesitate to contact your PhD school, and keep us informed in case of difficulties.
