
## Advances in Radioactive Isotope Science




## Some last minute information concerning the conference:

The **welcome reception** will take place in the *Jardin Benoit XII of the Palais des Papes*, starting Sunday June 4<sup>th</sup> 2023 at 19h00 (7pm). NOTE: the entrance to the garden (jardin) is on the opposite site of the main entrance! (see map, right). The main entrance of the Palais des Papes will not be open. Just follow the path around the *Palais* (keeping it to your left) to reach the entrance to the garden.



The conference will begin Monday June 5<sup>th</sup> at 8:45 am in the Conclave room (directions will be on display in the Palace). Check in will take place in the *Salles des Gardes*, near the entrance. The Palais will be open to you from 8:00 am. The Palais main entrance is for the public visits and the congress center entrance is located slightly to the left when facing the Palace (see photograph below).



Talks: there will be 40 **invited** talks over the week, in plenary sessions. These are **20 minutes plus 5 minutes** for questions. We have scheduled 81 contributed talks, in parallel sessions during Tuesday and Wednesday. The time for **contributed** talks is **12 minutes plus 3 minutes** for questions. To allow delegates to move between the parallel sessions, it is very important to respect these time constraints for smooth synchronization. There will also be a public lecture on Monday evening, starting at 18:00 (see program for details).

Posters: two **poster sessions** will be held in the *Paneterie* room, adjacent to the *Benoit XII cloister*. Please bring your A1 or A0 poster in portrait format for display (material will be provided to hang the posters). As a courtesy to registered presenters, we ask that you not bring/present posters for colleagues not attending the conference.

Proceedings: we plan to publish the contributions in EJPA Web of Conferences. If you do not wish to make a contribution then your submitted abstract will be included by default. Details about the proceedings will follow.
