 - EOSC Executive and Governance Boards (EB and GB) + EC DG RTD + DG CNECT

 - The proposals are now being taken into the next step of preparation which includes the gathering of potential commitments by relevant, interested stakeholders.
 - Conceived as a co-programmed European partnership, the EOSC candidate partnership **requires the existence of a legal entity** to enter into a contractual arrangement with the EC.
- Creation AISBL (*association internationale sans but lucratif*)

Legal entity statutes

Principaux éléments des statuts:

- 3 types de organisations membres sont prévus: les membres mandatés et réguliers et les observateurs. Les membres mandatés et réguliers peuvent voter et doivent payer des frais d'adhésion (valeur à déterminer), les observateurs ne votent pas et adhèrent gratuitement. Le CNRS serait, pour le moment, membre mandaté.
- le *membership fee* n'est pas encore discutée (2 M€ total? *). Il sera fixé par l'association une fois créé. Après cela, il reste la possibilité pour le CNRS de quitter l'association, s'il n'accepte pas les conditions et / ou la cotisation.
- structure de gouvernance: une assemblée générale qui détermine un comité exécutif, qui propose ensuite un directeur exécutif.
- Les membres mandatés (comme le CNRS) sont plus reconnus dans les votes en raison d'une règle "double majorité"
