2011-Earthquake recovery program extended up to 2031 by Parliament on June 5<sup>th</sup>

ILC now explicitly mentioned among potential programs For Tohoku region recovery

Consideration of upgrades now encouraged (even beyond 1 TeV)


In cases where international research and development projects, such as the International

projects can be hosted in the disaster-stricken areas.







# Transition of LCB/LCC to ILC-IDT

## ICFA approval expected early August

- LCB has been preparing for a proposal to ICFA to establish the ILC International Development Team (ILC-IDT) succeeding LCB/LCC. The team will be created by ICFA, with KEK as the host with some support from FALC
- The main gaol of the ILC-IDT is setting-up the ILC Pre-lab in a short timescale (one to two years), for the construction of the ILC in Japan.
- The ILC Pre-lab will be still based on the cooperation among national and international laboratories with KEK as the hub-laboratory. Thus the ILC-IDT must work closely with the regions to establish cooperation agreements.
- It should also provide an international framework for the continuation of the accelerator R&D and design work as well as the effort in physics and detector for the smooth start-up of the ILC Pre-lab
- The ILC-IDT will be based on the Executive Group and three Working Groups under: WG1(Pre-lab setup), WG2(Accelerator), WG3(Physics and Detector)

**Executive Group expected to be known early August** 

3 Working Groups expected to be set up early Autumn

## **IMPLICATION DU CERN**

CERN starting to be pro-active to participate to the ILC-IDT phase:

## **Bilateral agreement for Development Phase CERN-KEK:**

- Recall background, ILC, ICFA statement, LCC history and Strategy
- Areas of collaboration CERN-KEK related to ILC (many existing agreements)
- Move of LCC hosting at CERN to KEK for ILC activities (WEB, news, common fund accounts)
- CERN facilitates European involvement in Dev. Phase (common fund, CERN office at KEK can help, WG participation, etc)

ILC included in LC activities funded by the CERN mid-term plan approved last week

Potential relevance of similar national bilateral agreements being discussed
