CV of Christian Spiering

Christian Spiering, born 1948, studied Physics at the Humboldt University in Berlin. After having made his PhD he worked for 4.5 years in Dubna and Protvino (USSR). In 1988 he moved from particle physics at accelerators to astroparticle physics. Until his retirement in 2013 he led the neutrino astrophysics group in DESY/Zeuthen. He has worked in the Lake Baikal project and in the South Pole project AMANDA (European Spokesperson 1997-2005) and its successor IceCube (spokesperson 2005-2007). From 2014 to 2017 he chaired the Global Neutrino Network.
