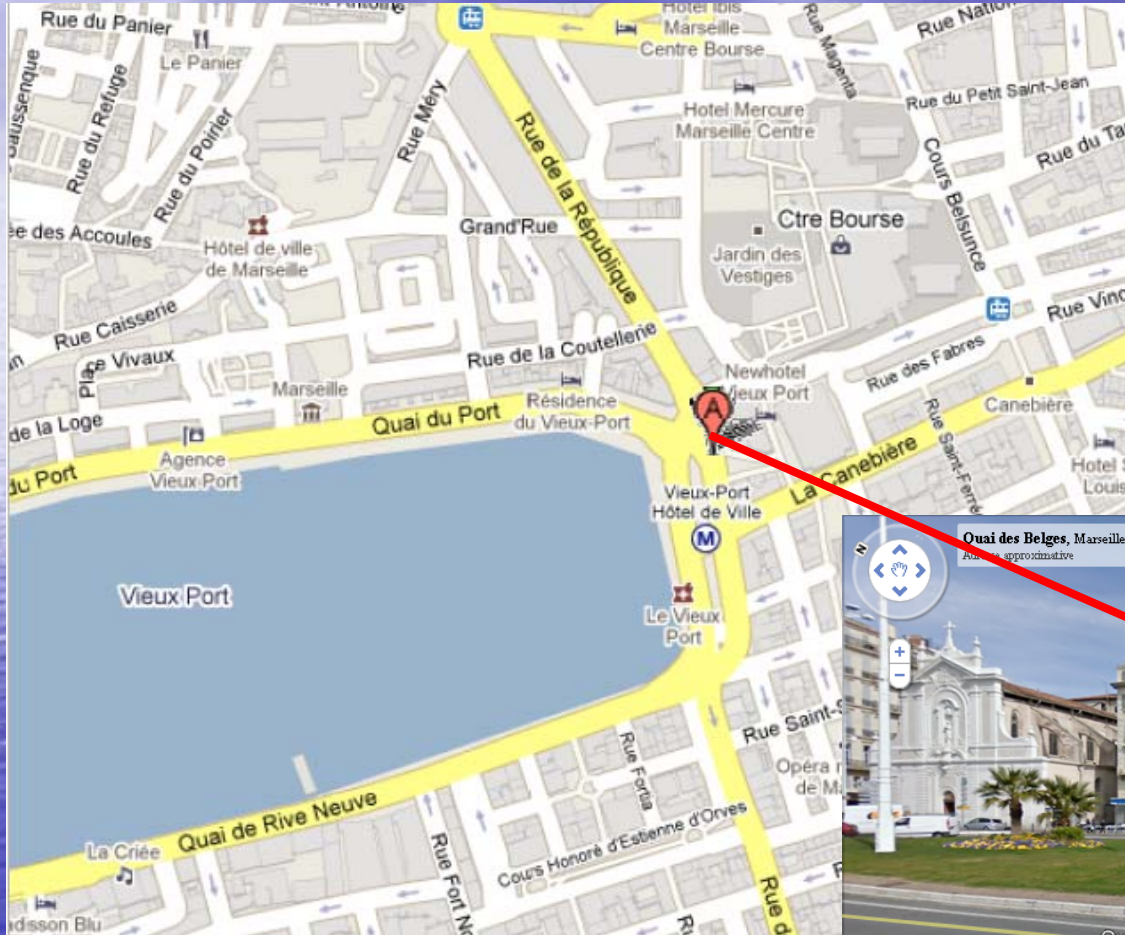


# Information for tomorrow



On Sunday, we will meet at **9AMAM** on the old port of Marseille with a bus departure to Cassis at **9:20AM** sharp.

Be back at the bus by **4PM!!** We leave **4:15PM**



- Possibility of a boat trip from Cassis (optional)
  - Visit the Mediterranean coast (~30 minutes to 1h30 trips)



- In Cassis, you **will be free** to choose your restaurant and have a
- **boat trip**: around the "Calanques" (from 45 min in boat for 3 Calanques to **1h30 for 8 Calanques** with great pictures of the cliffs along the shore).

- prices range between **20 euros** per person.
- You just show up 40 minutes before the time you want to take the tour and stand in line (from the port).
- **It may be busy at this time of the summer!**

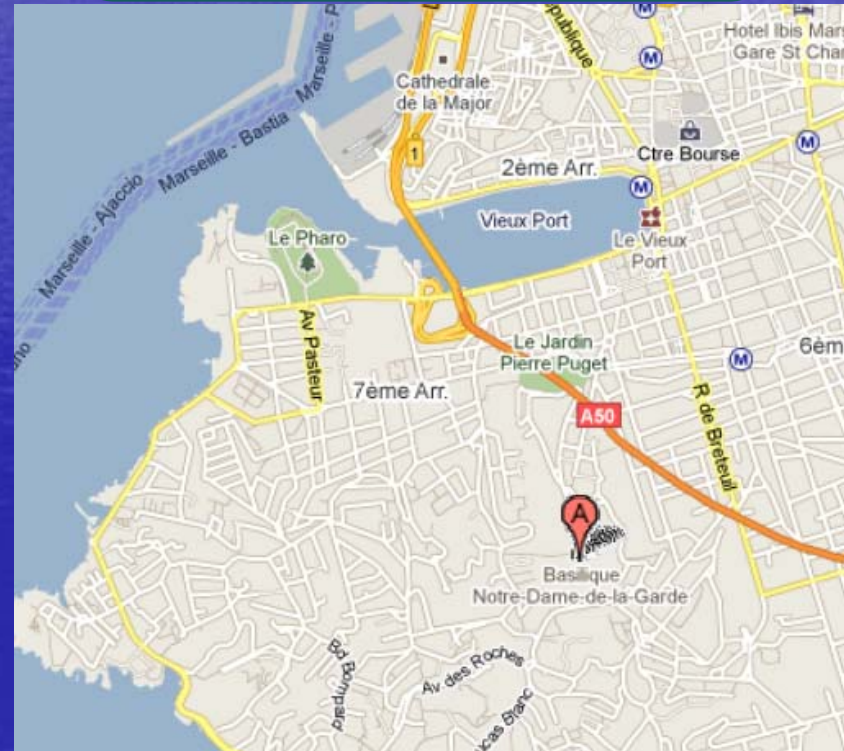

Stop by "Notre Dame de la Garde" (45') on the way back from Cassis  
(from 16h45 to 17h30) "Notre Bonne Mere" ("our good mother") is a basilica located at the highest natural point in Marseille (532 ft) where you can have a nice panoramic view of the sea and of the city

# Timeline summary (Sunday)

- **9:15AM:** the workshop buses will leave from the Old Port (you know where)
- **10AM:** we arrive at the parking in Cassis
- **10:05AM:** local little touristic train (free I been told!) to go the center
  - note: capability of 60-70 people/train
  - a departure every 15 minutes (i.e. two rounds)
- **10:30AM :** center of Cassis
  - boat
  - beach
  - restaurant
- **4PM:** you should arrange to be back at the parking at 4PM using the train...
- **4:15PM:** buses departure
- **5PM:** group picture + visit Notre Dame
- **5:45-6PM:** Buses leave for the old port
