
Information for tomorrow



Possibility of a boat trip from Cassis (optional)

Visit the Mediterranean cost (~30 minutes to 1h30 trips)

• In Cassis, you will be free to choose your restaurant and have a

- prices range between 20 euros per person.

- It may be busy at this time of the summer!


