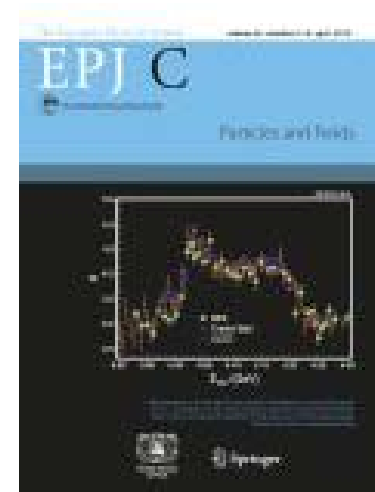
APS not set up to publish such a manuscript

From Professor Siegfried Bethke we have learned that you have agreed to submit a review article provisionally entitled "Physics of the B-Factories" for **publication in The European Physical Journal C – Particles and Fields, and, subsequently, in the annual volume of the review book series 'Advances in the Physics of Particles and Nuclei'**.
