We will present the collaborative work between astrophysicists and computer scientists to explore classification of optical transients. The optical transient time series, captured with its scene (usually a galaxy in the background) is used as raw input into a convolutional attention network to perform supervised learning on several classes of astrophysical transient objects. Results and comparison with other state-of-the-art methods are presented.
