## Activities

### French Budget 2023

- Trajectory: OK for now.

### French Budget 2024

- EAOM (Entretien Annuel Objectifs et Moyens): presence of DMLab directors + IN2P3 directorate + reps from DESY, GSI, KIT (de facto Steering Committee)
  - Autumn 2023: need to check the availability of SC
- Requests for 2024: need to converge (DIALOG) before summer break. Suggest to talk to you 1-by-1 for order 15minute slots. Proposal: 27 and 28 July. **Your input?**

### Sabbaticals

- Need to know 6 months to 1 year in advance for administrative and budgetary reasons

### Funding requests DFG-ANR

- 2022-2023: lead ANR, ongoing 1 project in the running, 1 administrative glitch
- 2023-2024: lead DFG (call not yet out, N-2: [DFG-ANR 2022](#) and the instructions: [Instructions 2022](#))
  - 36 months maximal length
  - submission to DFG (elan) **and** ANR with the **same** acronym
  - Likely deadline Mid-January 2024 (N-1 for ANR)
  - overleaf has a DFG [Template](#) (needs to be checked against requirements)
  - Thomas and Dirk can provide a “support statement” (let us know)
