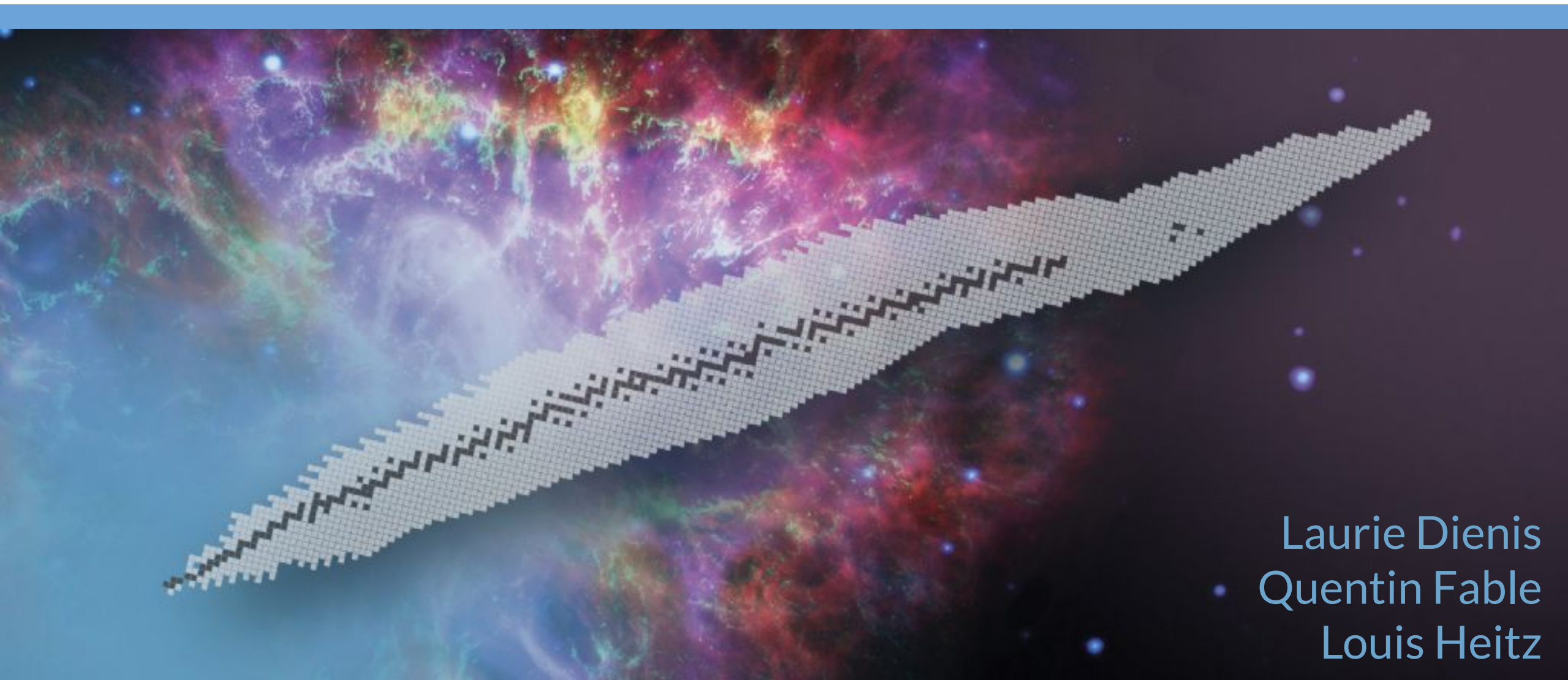

(Reactions, Structure and Nuclear Astrophysics: Experiences and Theories)

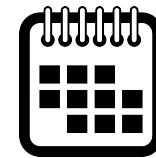
## What ?

The presentation are **40 minutes**, followed by an interactive **question and answer** session.

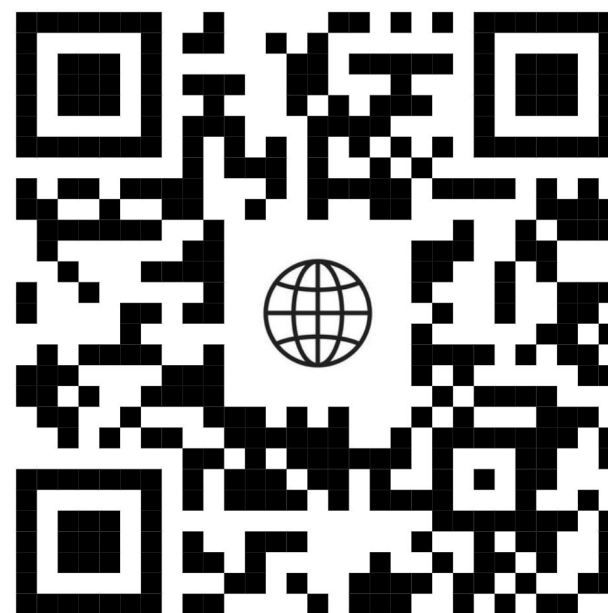
