- The hiring evaluation is open until **February 9<sup>th</sup> 1PM** (Paris time)
  - $\rightarrow$  Candidate <u>guide</u>
  - $\rightarrow$  Enrol directly <u>on the web</u>

Time line:

- March June : eligibility phase (review of applications and auditions, the latter not being systematic for research director competitions).
- June July : admission phase (admissions jury)
- October 1: appointment and assumption of duties (with possibility of postponement to the 1st of the following month until February 1 N+1)

#### Concours CNRS 2021 - offer

- The positions are mostly attached to a laboratory and an activity.
- When it is not the case (poste blanc), you can propose your project on a given topic and in one (or more) possible laboratories (establish some contact in advance). You can accompany the proposal with a letter from the laboratory director.
- You can apply to several positions
- You don't have to be already active on the given topic you apply for, as far as you are willing to work on it and you prove you have the needed skills to get involved.

### Concours CNRS 2024 - application

- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of Ph.D. diploma
- A report on your work [same if you apply for several positions]
- The complete list of your publications as well as your most significant publications (7 max for CR, 10 max for DR)
- Your research project, citing only CNRS laboratories (check offer) [adapted to the position you apply to]
- The report of your thesis jury as well as your complete thesis (optional but recommended)
- Recommendation letters [not compulsory] must be uploaded directly <u>here</u> (mostly for CR?)

#### Application - suggestions

- Take the time to work on your application, contact concerned groups in laboratories
- Request recommendation letters (if any) well in advance
- Ask colleagues to review it and comment
