Homage to Carlo Guaraldo (1938 - 2024)





- 1960 marked the start of Carlo's carrier at LNF.
- He was a member ofTorino-Frascati-Dubna collaboration (TOFRADUP) and leader of ALFA3 project
- He was involved in PS179 and later in the OBELIX (PS201) experiment, where he served as spokesmen.
- In the 1990s, Guaraldo supported the realization of the DAFNE complex.
- Carlo initiated and led a series of successful projects funded by EU commission, coordinating HadronPhysics, HadronPhysics2, and HadronPhysics3 initiatives from 2004 to 2014. These projects provided open access to six world-class experimental facilities (COSY, MAMI, LNF, ELSA, GSI/FAIR, and CERN) and the European Centre for Theoretical Physics ECT* in Trento.
- He made an invaluable contribution to the STRONG-2020 project as Deputy Coordinator and member of the Executive and Governing Boards.



Final Report

- The Report to be prepared and submitted within 60 days (1 August-30 September 2024)
- The templates for scientific part will be provided by Management Team
- Financial Part to be completed directly in the Portal

Additional elements

 Final review can be lead by REA (review of final report and all periodic reports)

Closure/Final payments

- After acceptance of final report: payment of the balance to CNRS (Coordinator)
- Should be done within 90 days after accepting the final report
- Release of 15% of the total budget by the Commission
