



# **Relationship with superiors**




Very bad

# Integration




Not integrated at all

"It could be nice to have more interaction between groups."



"More social events, organize occasions to get to know permanent researchers and other people of the laboratory."


Language barrier: "It is very difficult to get to know other people in the lab, especially if you don't speak (much) french."

- "It's OK"


- "Not entirely"


# More thoughts on this topic:

"I think there should be a support or introduction for PHD students that want to give lectures (ie: find how to get a teaching contract, who to contact ...)" "Maybe organize wellness sessions (yoga, sophrology, theatre) to learn how to handle stress and provide group/team-building activities."

"There could be a more **scientific ambience** - e.g. have journal clubs and cafés where PhDs present to the whole lab (and not just to other PhDs like in the PhD conferences) to encourage collaboration and discussion between **junior and senior** staff, etc."

What about **social activities**  $\rightarrow$  formal offers & self organization?


