CMS outreach overview

The CMS experiment is one of the largest international scientific collaborations in history, involving more than 6000 particle physicists, engineers, technicians, students and support staff from 250+ institutes in 55+ countries. The physics program and technical achievements of CMS are of great interest to a wide range of stakeholders, ranging from the general public, other scientists, journalists to politicians. We summarise the ongoing activities within the framework of Communications/Outreach, including: Visits (in-person and virtual); Web-based articles covering physics analysis, operations and upgrades; Exhibitions; Social Media (stories, blogs, photos, videos) and the use of technologies such as Virtual Relaity.
