

PhysTeV: history in a nutshell

A series of workshops that started in 1999. This is the **13th edition**

- 1999: 65 participants, 1 session, 2 weeks
- 2005: ~170 applications, 3 weeks
- 2007: ~300 applications
- 2009 today: 2 sessions, 60-70 participants per session
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- ◆ 2021: covid → only few zoom sessions
- 2023: almost covid free

Aim and format of the workshop

- Bringing together theorists and experimentalists working on several aspects of phenomenology at TeV colliders and other experiments.
- Collaborations, intense discussions and brainstorming. Formal talks kept to a minimum, informal presentations encouraged.
- Unique opportunity: ~10 days of informal TH/EXP discussions facing Mont Blanc.
- There's no predefined agenda: feel free to suggest new ideas!
- "important cornerstone of our field!", "...Les Houches has truly made a difference to our field"










Programme
