#### What problem(s) are you going to solve?

Trans-national research into the Holocaust can be challenging due to:

- fragmentation caused by destruction of evidence, migration, and other issues
- scale of historical documentation and its geographic dispersal
- multilinguality and diversity of collection holders



#### What are you planning to do to solve the problem?

EHRI-KG will develop a comprehensive Linked Open Data (LOD) Knowledge Graph

Building on the archival data on the **EHRI Portal** (<a href="https://portal.ehri-project.eu/">https://portal.ehri-project.eu/</a>) the Knowledge Graph will provide LOD access to information about sources, collection holders, people, places, and more.

The technical approaches to building the KG will be adaptable by collection holders seeking to make their archival metadata more accessible.



# What will be the results and how do you plan to make them available to the broader community?

EHRI's Knowledge Graph will be **in production** and connected to the wider ecosystem of LOD sources.

Outputs will be integrated into **EOSC** via cluster project **SSHOC**.

All code and resources will be open source and documented for re-use.
