First circular

The 24th GANIL Colloque will be held in the Vosges Mountains, in Bussang. The purpose of the conference is to review and discuss the research carried out at GANIL and at other facilities around the world. The Colloque will cover the range of topics addressed at GANIL:

- Shell evolution
- Collective modes
- Fission
- Heavy ion Collisions
- Heavy & Superheavy nuclei
- Present & Future GANIL facilities
- Fundamental Interactions
- Interdisciplinary Research
- Application
- Astrophysics
- Facilities & associated instrumentation

Sessions will start on Monday morning, September 21st, and end at lunch on Friday, September 25th. We foresee 15 sessions of 1h30 to 2h, as well as a poster session.

The program will include a number of invited review talks (20+5 min) followed by contributed, shorter talks (15+5 min), selected on the basis of abstracts. A number of presentations will be allotted to contributions given by graduate students. One poster session will also be organised to allow presentations of more submitted contributions. The best poster will be awarded a 15 min oral presentation on the last day of the Colloque. The Colloque will also give the opportunity to reward the best GANIL thesis award by the director of GANIL, followed by a 15+5 min presentation of the laureate.

The Colloque will be held in the [Resort Village Azureva Bussang](#) in the Vosges Mountain. The registration fee, including accommodation, full board from September 20th (Sunday dinner) to September 25th (Friday lunch) and conference dinner, are **500 €** (VAT included) for a **single room** and **250 €** (VAT included) **for each person in a twin room**. A number of places “**free of charge**” will be attributed **to students and young researchers** with a selected talk or a selected poster contribution.

In order to preserve the informal character of the Colloque and to stimulate the presentation of innovative ideas, no proceedings will be published. To favour informal exchanges in a relaxed atmosphere, early afternoons will be free of talks. As usual, we ask the interested persons to stay for the full 5 days of the Colloque, in order to increase the interactions among participants. Excursions will be proposed to the participants on Wednesday afternoon.
