

## Location



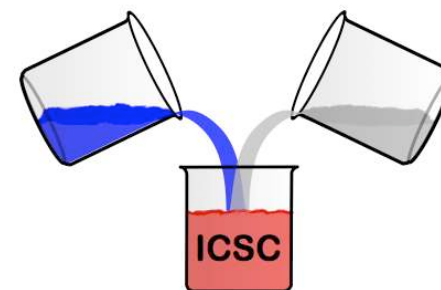

The end of August is warm and pleasant with daily temperatures between 25°C and 30°C.

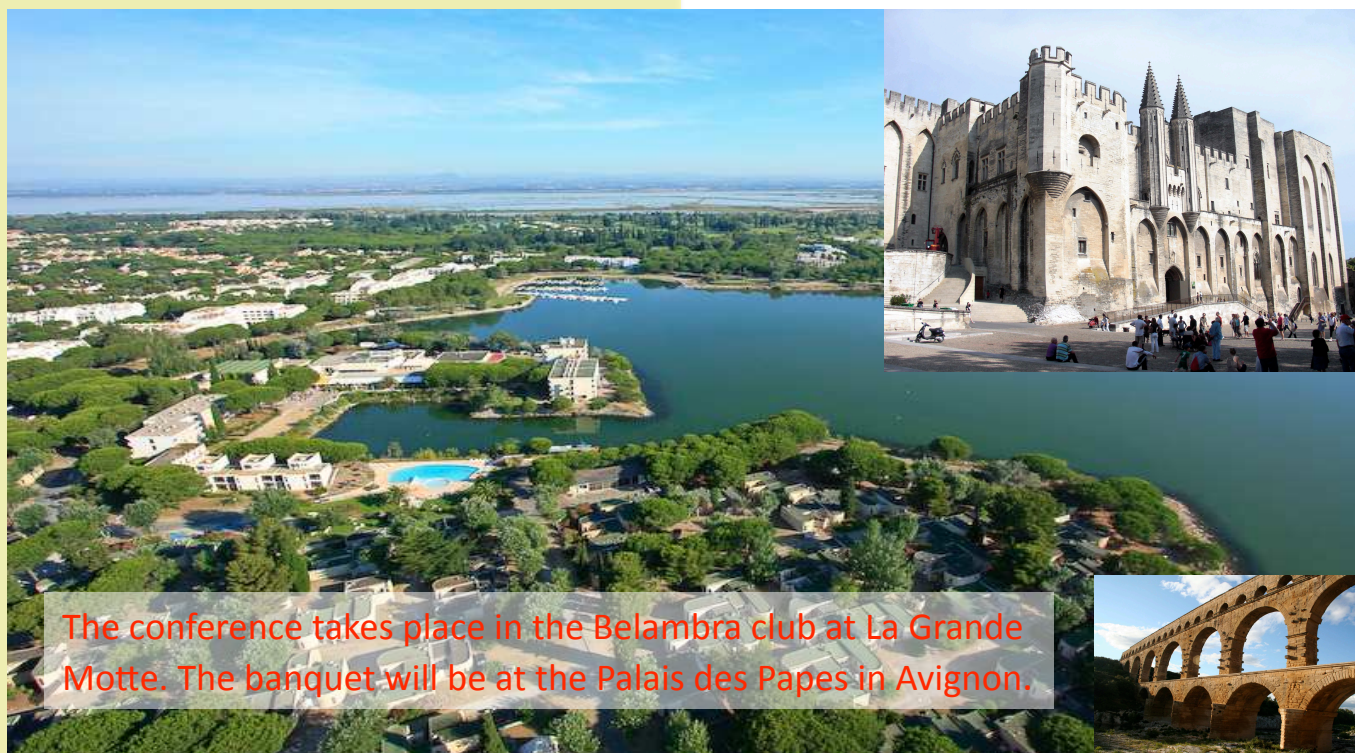
## First announcement
