

News from CC-IN2P3

- **Up to now: two 'groups' at CC, 'indra' + 'fazia':**
 - 'indra': disk space (/sps/indra, /pbs/throng/indra) + iRODS/HPSS instance (/indra)
 - 'fazia': disk space (/sps/fazia, /pbs/throng/fazia) + iRODS/HPSS instance (/fazia)
 - 2 separate software environments to maintain/synchronize
 - Experimental data separated ('indra' → INDRA data; 'fazia' → FAZIA + INDRAFAZIA data)
- **Proposed evolution: merge into 1 group, 'indrafazia'**
 - 1 single iRODS/HPSS instance, with all data from INDRA, FAZIA & INDRAFAZIA
 - 1 single /sps/indrafazia space, after CLEAN UP of existing /sps
 - /sps = SEMI-PERMANENT STORAGE
 - Not intended for archiving/long-term storage (but everybody does it)
 - In 2026: upgrade of /sps disk infrastructure: **'automatic' delete of files not used for >2 years!**

 - Probable data-taking at GANIL end of March/beginning April: should merge before this!
 - Any critical cases (e.g. Ph.D in final urgent analysis stage) which forbid interruption of service between now and end of March?
