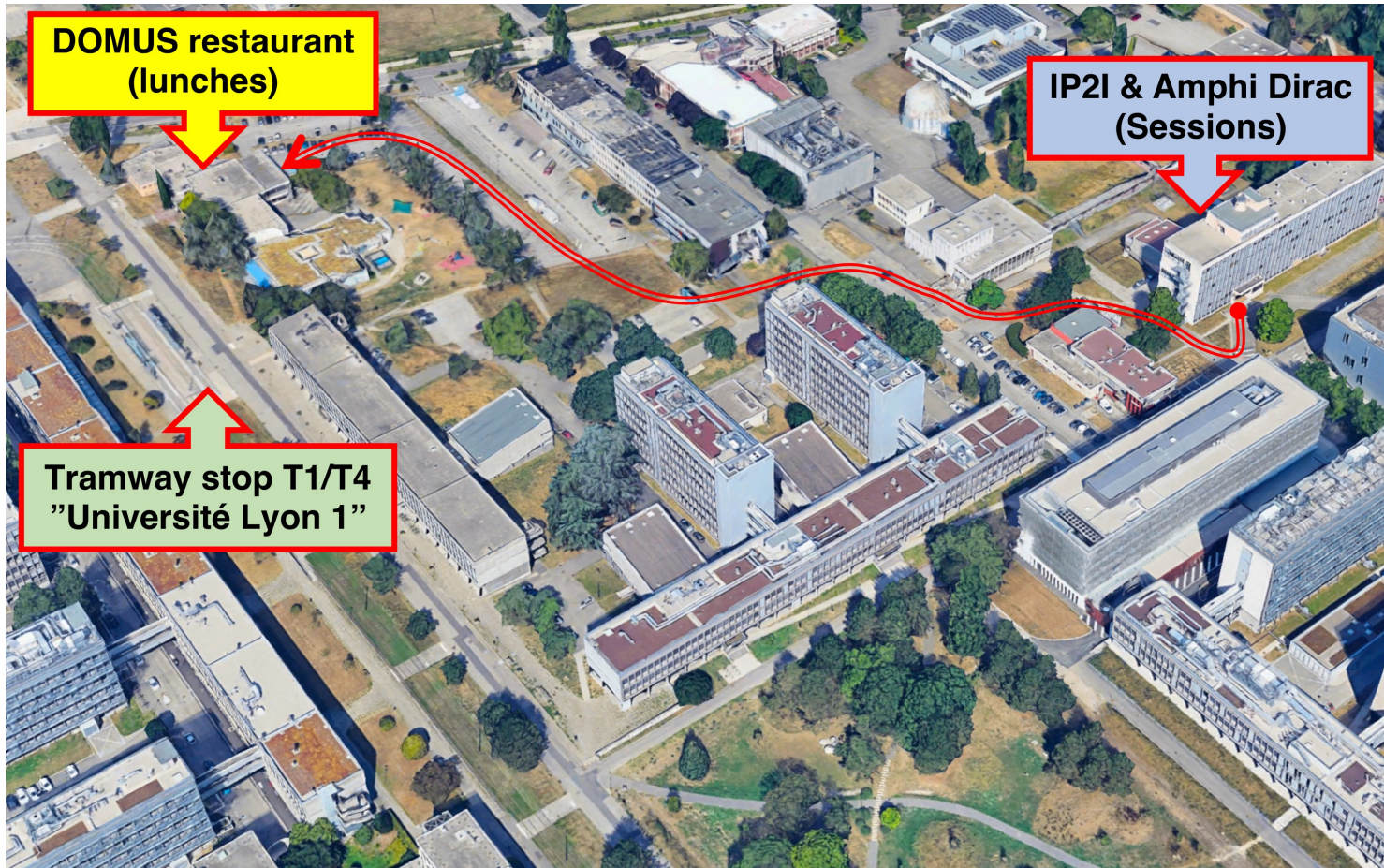
Power outlets

Room access during breaks

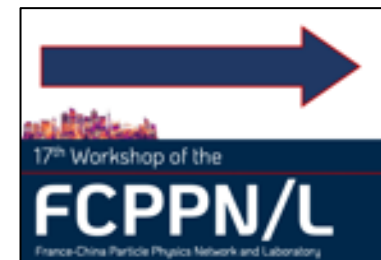

The **TCL (Transports en Commun Lyonnais)** network includes:

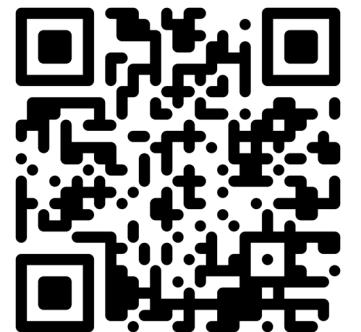
-  **4 Metro lines** (A, B, C, D)

Tram T4/T6 – *La Doua – Gaston Berger*

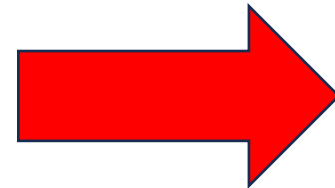


Public Transportation

Tickets and Payment

Tickets are valid on all TCL services (metro, tram, bus and funicular), including transfers. Tickets can be purchased:

- at ticket machines in metro and tram stations
- via the **TCL mobile app**
- directly on **contactless bank cards** or **smartphones** (no ticket needed)



Remember to validate your ticket or your **contactless bank card** or **smartphone** when boarding or entering the metro.

Public Transportation



Beware of Pickpockets

Lyon is generally a safe city.
However, **pickpockets may operate in crowded places**, especially:

- metro and tramway vehicles
- railway stations
- tourist attractions
- busy shopping streets

Please:

- ❖ keep your valuables secure
- ❖ avoid carrying wallets or phones in back pockets
- ❖ keep your luggage with you at all times

T1/T4 Disruptions

 **TCL T1/T4 Disruptions from Mon. Jun 29 to Thu. Jul 2 after 9:00 PM**

- ❖ **T1 will only run between *Debourg* and *Place des Archives*.** It will **not serve** the rest of the line up to *IUT Feyssine* (including *Perrache*, *Guillotière*, *Gare Part-Dieu*, *Charpennes*, and *La Doua*)
- ❖ **T4 will only run between *Hôpital Feyzin Vénissieux* and *Gare Part-Dieu Villette*.** It will **not serve** any stations between *Thiers-Lafayette* and *La Doua – Gaston Berger* (including *Charpennes*)

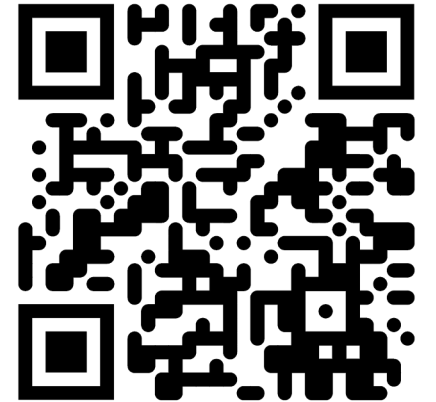
