We hoped you enjoyed HCP in Paris!

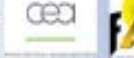

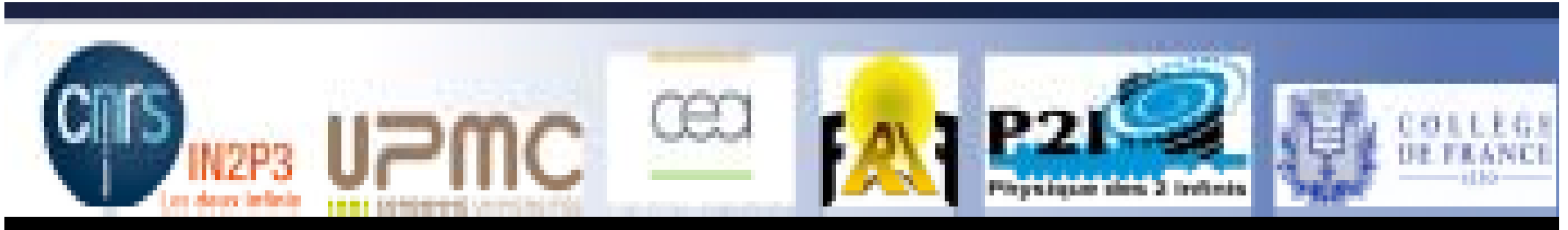
