please find below some information regarding your participation in the Invisibles Workshop 14, which will be held at the Institut des Cordeliers, 21 rue de l'École de Médecine, Paris 6ème arrondissement.

We recall that the closest stations (a few minutes walk) are

Metro (underground): Line 10 "Odéon" and "Cluny - La Sorbonne", Line 4 "St Michel"

RER A & B (local trains): "Saint Michel - Notre Dame"; RER B: "Luxembourg"

Bus: Lines 63, 86, 87 "Odéon" et "Cluny - La Sorbonne"

Registration begins at 9h00 on Monday, at the Entrance Hall (entering at 21 rue de l'École de Médecine). The Workshop begins at 9h45 (see the webpage for the **programme** & **timetable**).

The presentations will take place in the "Amphitheâtre Pasquier".

Coffee breaks & Lunches will be held in the Institute's garden and cloister.

On Monday evening (July 14), a Reception will be at the "Salle Marie Curie".

Wifi at the "Institut des Cordeliers":


You will be given a personal wifi connection access code, which you can find inside your badge holder.

Posters will be presented at the **Institute's cloister.** Notice that there will be no local printing facilities, so bring your poster prepared!

Conference Dinner and Event:

On Thursday evening, the "Invisibles 14" participants are welcome to board the "Zouave" - a Bateau-Mouche - at the Pont de l'Alma, for a scenic cruise along the Seine river. Dinner will be served on board (during the cruise).



Boarding and landing take place at the "Port de la Conférence - Pont de l'Alma", on the Rive Droite (8th arrondissement of Paris).

Boarding will be at **20h00** (please be there at least 15min before!); we will **return** at **23h00**.

Your Workshop Dinner/Event ticket can be found inside your badge. Notice that you need to present it in order to board.

14th of July in Paris:

The Workshop begins on July 14, which is France's National holiday, commemorating the "Prise de la Bastille" in 1789.
